How to use the Escavox traceability digital platform in the classroom

In our Traceability of Gippsland Produce lessons students learn about the challenges associated with local and international supply chains and how technology is helping to move food safely to destinations around Australia and overseas. Using the Escavox platform, students can explore the application of real world data analytics to identify problems and develop solutions to the problems of food safety, food waste, and food fraud. They will learn about the importance of temperature and time to the transportation of food, study statistics to make inferences about the status of different supply chains, and use multiple sources of information to make judgments and decisions.

These interactive webinars will support teachers to use and adapt the Traceability of Gippsland Produce lessons for their curriculum and lesson plans.
